Dear Mayor Bevilacqua:

As you know, I recently met with members of the Concord West Ratepayers Association and the Concord West Seniors Club to discuss an issue within their neighbourhood that involves lands held by the provincial government.

An Environmental Assessment has been filed by the Ministry of Transportation for the construction of the 407 Transitway between Highway 400 and Kennedy Road. They have raised concerns over the planned construction of a Transit Station in Concord and are in the process of filing their comments to the Ministry of the Environment opposing the filed plans.

At the meeting, members requested a meeting with you and my office to discuss this issue. Plans to build the transit station are contingent with development in the area. As planning falls under the jurisdiction of the municipal government, I am requesting that a meeting be convened to discuss our mutual interests on this project.
